- 3. Memorize one line of the song and then play it without the music
- 4. Play the song on the lowest notes of the piano
- 5. Play the song on the highest notes of the piano
- 6. Flat the 3rd and 6th to make the song minor
- 7. Play the entire song staccato
- 8. Start with the last measure and play the song in backwards order
- 9. Play the song standing up
- 10. Play the RH really high, and the LH really low
- 11. Roll one die again, only use that finger number for the whole song.
- 12. Play the song as fast as you possibly can!

Learn a new song!

- 2. Circle all of the sharps and flats that come from the key signature
- 3. Circle all of the dynamics in red
- 4. Roll the dice again, play that measure 5 times
- 5. Find the lowest and highest notes in the song, circle and write the names of the notes.
- 6. Find 3 different intervals, circle and name them with blue.
- 7. Write the name of the key, the tonic, and dominant notes.
- 8. Count all of the times you play the tonic note on the LH
- 9. Clap and count the first 2 lines
- 10. Write in the counts for the first2 lines
- 11. Learn the first measure and the last measure
- 12. Learn the last line of the song
